Sister Sez...

The Question? Read CCC 2538-2540.
How does the tenth commandment illuminate the sin of envy in the heart?

What does St. John Chrysostom prescribe as the best medicine for killing the sin of envy?

The Answer: The tenth commandment illuminates the fact that desiring another's goods for oneself (however one defines "goods") can lead us toward sins that keeps us from being united to God and to one another in love. St. John Chrysostom points out that the remedy for this sinful nature is to practice "good will", which is to

consciously rejoice in and proclaim the goodness and merits of others. This answer to envy, like the answer to pride and all the other capital sins, involves a deliberate act of the will, not merely an emotion.

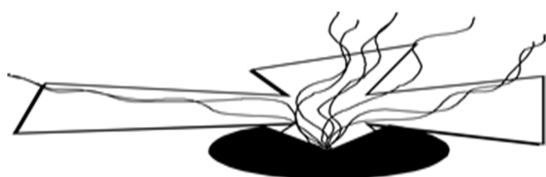
