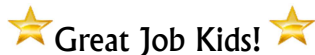

## PASTOR'S COLUMN

### **THAT MAN IS WHO? HEY MAN, IT'S YOU!**

It may not be too late, for those men who are interested. There was a big organizational pow-wow in Harrisburg last weekend, for men interested in the That Man Is You (TMIY) program. About 100 attended from around the diocese.

I talked to a key leader and he will come out to talk with us in the Juniata Valley if we get enough men interested in at least hearing of this movement. It is a

U.S. Catholic men's movement, emphasizing manly virtue, prayer, piety and "stepping up to the plate" in regard to our loving responsibility toward wife and children.

TMIY is sponsored by Paradisus Dei, a lay ministry founded in 2001 out of Houston, Tex., "to help families discover the superabundance of God within marriage," according to the web site ([www.paradisus.dei.org](http://www.paradisus.dei.org)).

The TMIY web site says that this men's movement "honestly addresses the pressures and temptations that men face in our modern culture, especially those related to their roles as husbands and fathers. The program harmonizes current social and medical science with the teaching of the Church and the wisdom of the saints to develop the vision of man fully alive. It is particularly indebted to the teachings of the Second Vatican council and Pope John Paul II."

A group of men meet on a weekday morning, say around 6 a.m. (yes, typically very early, before work). The doors open then for breakfast with music playing until 6:25 a.m., with opening comments by the leader. At 6:30 a.m. there will be a DVD presentation, followed by small group discussion at 7 a.m. and ending at 7:30 a.m.

There is a fall semester that will begin in September in the diocese and go until before Christmas. The second semester begins in January and goes until April. The web site says that each session has three essential elements: social gathering over a meal, DVD presentation, and small group discussion. The DVD content and discussion emphasize a man's three relationships: with God, with spouse, with children and how to improve all three.

The web site also contains shining endorsements from Archbishop Charles Chaput of Philadelphia and Cardinal Daniel Di Nardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston. It looks like about 20 parishes in our diocese will begin TMIY groups in the fall.

The title is taken from the confrontation by the prophet Nathan to King David, who has just arranged the battlefield murder of one of his generals to cover up David's adultery with the general's wife, Bathsheba, and her subsequent pregnancy.

Nathan tells David a story of a rich man stealing, slaughtering and eating a poor neighbor's only pet lamb and David is incensed, crying out "the man who has done this deserves to die..." And Nathan shoots back "That Man Is You!" or in some translations: "You Are The Man!" The story is told in 2 Samuel, chapters 11 and 12. King David admits guilt and repents, thus the title speaks to the membership in emulating King David in admitting fault and growing in virtue.

Dr. John Rossi, a personal friend of mine from New Cumberland, is involved in the program and will come to speak to those who are interested, with a view of getting groups started on either or both parishes. There will be sign-up sheets out for a couple of weeks in both parishes. Who should sign up? That Man Is You.

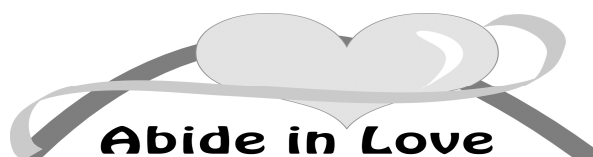

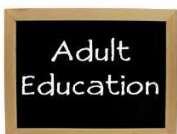
**A Journey toward the World Meeting of Families** - Bishop Gainer invites you to join him on a journey of prayer and healing for our families in
